ACCOUNTING

Rex & Bonnie Wilks Scholarship

To be awarded to a 2nd year, academic track student majoring in Accounting. 3.5 cumulative GPA required. The scholarship is to be awarded in the 2nd quarter of the student's sophomore year, providing that the student matriculates and maintains a 3.5 GPA. Primary considerations for awarding this scholarship will be 1) academic excellence, 2) leadership ability, 3) integrity, and 4) responsibility. Only when two students are equal in the four preceding requisites will financial need become a factor. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

ART

Dorothy Bonaudi Memorial Art Scholarship

Art student with cumulative GPA of at least 2.75. Must be a U.S. citizen. Needs recommendation of art instructor. Portfolio may be requested.

ATHLETIC

David Wyrick Memorial Scholarship

Must have 3.0 GPA from high school and maintain 2.75 GPA at Big Bend Community College. Must complete a minimum of 12 credits each quarter. Preference given to a student involved in athletics.

Grant County Seahawks Scholarship

Grant County resident, 2.5 GPA, athlete (basketball, volleyball, softball or baseball).

Ryan Floch Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship will be awarded to young men who participated in athletics at a Class B high school in Eastern Washington and graduated with a 3.0 grade point average. Must maintain a 2.75 grade point average at BBCC to keep the scholarship. Activities and public service as related to moral character will be considered. Participation in collegiate athletics is preferred but not required.

AVIATION

Blunt/Wheat Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a 2nd year student in the Commercial Pilot Training at Big Bend. The scholarship is to be used for flight fees.

Clyde W. & Audrey M. Owen Scholarship

To be awarded to a 2nd year flight student to pay for flight fees. Preference is given to students in stage 6 (instrument rating) and stage 7 (commercial pilot certificate). Applicants should be in good standing in the Commercial Pilot Program and not on probation.

Lisa Khatibi Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is for a 2nd year Commercial Pilot student. Preference will be given to a female student with financial need. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Thomas R. Blaesing Scholarship

This scholarship is for flight fees for second-year students in stage 6 or stage 7 in good standing in the Commercial Pilot program. Preference for multi-engine fees.

EDUCATION

Alice Humphrey Memorial Scholarship

Education major, first priority. Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Calbick Family Education Scholarship

For transfer students in education. Applicants need a 3.0 GPA and plan to transfer to a 4-year accredited college or university in the state of Washington.

Ferne Daniel Family Scholarship

Education or Agriculture major. Must meet financial eligibility as determined by the Financial Aid Office, applying for first year at BBCC. The scholarship is renewable for the 2nd year to the same student, if needed.

Lou Ann Holgate Memorial Scholarship

BBCC 2nd year student pursuing a degree in special education and/or student with developmental disabilities pursuing a transfer degree in any BBCC program or field.

Valera Lea Stevens Memorial Scholarship

Student must have successfully completed one or more quarters at BBCC. Student's major should be in special education or an area where they would be working with handicapped students (if no majors in these areas, some form of education). Student should be from Eastern Washington with the first preference to the Big Bend Community College service district.

Victor/Hull/Click Scholarship

Education major. Potential and current students welcome to apply.

GENERAL

Big Bend Community College Foundation-Returning Student Scholarships

These scholarships are available to returning Big Bend Community College students. Recipient must have been a resident of the Big Bend Community College service district for at least three years. Must maintain a 2.75 cumulative grade point average at BBCC to keep the scholarship. Must be full-time students.

Al Roth Memorial Scholarship

Student must have financial need. Any major. Must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or better at the end of each quarter. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

American Legion Auxiliary #209 Scholarship

Must have a veteran in the family, ie. father, brother, sister, grandparent, etc. Open to graduating high school seniors from Moses Lake or Warden high schools, or a Big Bend Community College student.

Art Erickson Memorial Scholarship

Non-traditional, returning students welcome to apply.

Bert Smith Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Charles & Evelyn Dost Trust Scholarship

Applicant must be a needy student with at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA, and exhibit good moral character. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Don Worley Memorial Scholarship

Student must be at least 25 years old and working toward a certificate or degree.

Earl & Ruby Holloway Scholarship

Applicant must be at least 25 years of age and have completed 36 credits in a specific approved program with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 in any major. Student must have unmet need from financial aid application. The funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, or other educational expenses. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Ed & Signe Williamson Scholarship

Recipient must have been a resident of the Big Bend Community College service district for at least three years. Must complete a minimum of 12 credits in any given quarter toward their degree program. Must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or better at the end of each quarter.

Faculty Association Scholarship

Based on need and minimum GPA of 3.5. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

George Delaney Memorial Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Harry Masto Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Japanese Supplementary School of Moses Lake Scholarship

For current graduates of Moses Lake High School attending BBCC.

Jay Cerenzia Memorial Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

John and Roger Glaese Scholarship

Slight preference for re-entry students. Must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.70 for continued eligibility. Must maintain full-time student status of 12 or more credits per quarter.

John O. & Kathryn G. Green Memorial Scholarship

Non-Traditional Student. Graduate of a Columbia Basin high school or a resident of the Basin for more than 5 years. Thirty years of age or older. This scholarship is for individuals who have a desire to improve their lives and the lives of their families and realize the only way to do so is through education, i.e., teacher aids who want to be teachers, bookkeepers who want to be accountants, mechanics who want to own their own business.

Moses Lake Industries Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Moses Lake/Othello Realtors' Association Scholarship

Potential and current students welcome to apply.

Moses Lake Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Ladies Auxiliary Scholarship

In order of priority : for veterans, family members of veterans, or descendents of veterans. Can be a full or part-time student.

National Association of Professional Mortgage Women Scholarship

Both male and female applicants are encouraged to apply. Must be a full-time student pursuing an education in business, preferably the mortgage/banking industry. Must maintain a 3.0 or better cumulative GPA and be a second year student (already completed 45 credits).

Paul & Gilma Preus Memorial Scholarship

Single parent with child under 18, having completed 36 credit hours with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, have financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Robert Lyon Memorial Scholarship

Full time student, native of local area will be given preference.

Roy & Leona Nelson Foundation Scholarships

Open to potential and current students native to Eastern Washington and Northern Idaho. Must be a full-time student with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Warren and Ruth Osborne Memorial Scholarships

Resident of rural Grant County, preferably Wilson Creek/Hartline area. Must be full-time and have a 2.75 GPA.

LAW ENFORCEMENT

Grant, Adams, Lincoln County Peace Officer's Association Scholarship

The priority of selection for this scholarship is:

1. Student in any program from a law enforcement family resident in Grant, Adams, or Lincoln County, with verifiable financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.
2. Any student interested in law enforcement or criminal justice career (probation, correction, parole, etc.) with a verifiable financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.
3. If there are no eligible applicants (1-2 above), the scholarship will be awarded to a student in any program. The recipient must meet the other criteria as stated below and have verifiable financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Other Criteria:

1. Preference will be given to a resident of Grant, Adams or Lincoln County.
2. Scholarship is available to both freshmen and sophomores.
3. Applicants must have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (high school or college).
4. The student must maintain a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA.

MATH / SCIENCE / AGRICULTURE

Barry Kirkwood Scholarship

Preference to student majoring in agriculture or a related program of study. If no qualified applicant in agriculture field, scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the selection committee.

Charles (Chuck) Huston Memorial Scholarship

Second year, academic track student in agriculture or the sciences (hard sciences—not social sciences). Applicant must have a 3.0 to be considered for the scholarship. Economic need of student is equally important as grade point. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Chester J. Calbick Physics, Math and Science Scholarship

For transfer students in physics (preferred), math, or science. Applicants need a 3.0 GPA and plan to transfer to a 4-year accredited college or university in the state of Washington.

DeForest “Huck” Fuller/Moses Lake Grange Scholarship

Preference given to descendents of Grange members, students from farm families, or students from families who work in agriculture-related industries. Minimum GPA to apply is 3.0 in high school or 2.75 in college. Must maintain a GPA of 2.75 at BBCC. Applicant must be a resident of Grant County for a minimum of three years.

Ferne Daniel Family Scholarship

Education or Agriculture major, meet financial eligibility as determined by the Financial Aid Office, applying for first year at BBCC, with the scholarship renewable for the 2nd year to the same student, if needed. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

George Champie Memorial Scholarship

Student must be a Computer Science or Math Major.

John Michael Shinn Memorial Scholarship

One year scholarship for a 2nd year student majoring in Agriculture and/or the sciences (hard sciences—not social sciences). Student must show promise of developing into a creative thinker and experimenter. *NOTE: Applicants for this scholarship must attach a written explanation of qualifications with the criteria...creative thinker and experimenter. Please attach to the completed application. In addition, please provide supported explanation or references from the community.*

White Trail Grange Scholarship

Must be a resident of the BBCC service district for at least five years and a graduate of a high school in the service district. Minimum GPA to apply is 3.0 in high school or 2.75 in college. First preference given to members of farm families. Agriculture major or program related to occupations serving production agriculture.

MINORITY STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Weinstein Beverage Scholarships

For Latino students enrolling in academic transfer programs.

Basic American Foods Scholarship

Ethnic minority scholarship, not based on need or academics.

NURSING

Dr. Harold & Gladys Tracy Scholarship

Full tuition for a 2nd year nursing student. Must demonstrate financial need and be a resident of the local area.

E.J. and Marjorie Ebel Nursing Scholarship

For full-time students accepted to the Associate Degree Nursing Program at BBCC. Must demonstrate financial need, and be a resident of the service district.

Hearthstone Resident Council Scholarship

Nursing major, minimum 2.75 GPA. Preference given to an older, single parent student returning for a career change. Must have unmet need from Financial Aid application. The award is to be made near the end of the first quarter of the 2nd year of the student's enrollment. Student must maintain a 2.75 GPA. Scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, and other educational expenses. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

Helen Heinemann Memorial Scholarship

Full-time student enrolled in the nursing program or other medically related field; must maintain a 2.75 GPA to retain scholarship. First preference given to a graduate of Ritzville High School; second preference to resident of Adams County; third preference to resident of BBCC service district.

Home & Community Educators of Grant/Adams Counties Scholarship

For students accepted to BBCC's Associate Degree Nursing Program, with preference for single parents with a desire to improve their life and the lives of family members. Must have unmet need from financial aid application. Must maintain a 2.75 GPA.

The Katherine Lewis Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Full-time student enrolled in nursing program; have a minimum 3.0 overall GPA, commitment, community service.

Kerry Trask Workman Memorial Scholarship

For a student enrolled in the Associate Degree Nursing Program who has resided in BBCC's service district more than three years. Must maintain a 3.0 GPA and full-time student status.

Larry & Lorraine Peterson Scholarship

Applicant must be full-time student accepted to a BBCC Nursing Program—at the Practical Nursing or Registered Nursing level. Student must maintain a 2.75 GPA. Preference will be given to returning students.

Lee Eggert Scholarship

Student must be in good standing at BBCC; be enrolled as a full-time student in the nursing program; have completed two quarters in the nursing program at BBCC; have a GPA of 3.0 in nursing classes; have a GPA of 2.75 in support classes; funds to be used for tuition/books, or fees for the nursing program.

Paul & Bertha Guffin Memorial Scholarship

Applicant must be full-time student accepted to a BBCC Nursing Program—at the Practical Nursing or Registered Nursing level.

Robert & Agnes Holloway Scholarship

For students accepted to BBCC's Associate Degree Nursing Program. Must have financial need and maintain full-time student status.

Wenatchee Valley Clinic Nursing Scholarship

Must be accepted into the Practical Nursing Program. Applicants should intend to pursue a career as a Registered Nurse. Financial need is considered. Academic performance is considered. Applicants must submit a letter stating their educational and career goals. Applicants are encouraged to have completed a Financial Aid Form to assist in selection process.

PART-TIME STUDENTS

Robert Mason Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to students enrolled in 8 or less credits.

BBCC Trustees Fund

This scholarship is for a part-time student who has completed 12 or more credits at BBCC. Student must maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA. Student need is a priority in the selection process.

PROFESSIONAL/TECHNICAL

Columbia Basin Dutch Oven Society

For students interested in a career in culinary arts, nutrition services, restaurant management, or food services management.

JoAnn Mahaney Scholarship

For students enrolled in BBCC's Industrial Electrical Technology Program.

Moses Lake Classic Car Club Scholarship

For students who enroll in BBCC's Automotive Technology Program, with preference to second-year students.

Moses Lake High School Automotive Scholarship

For Moses Lake High School automotive students who graduate from high school and plan to enroll in BBCC's Automotive Technology Program.

REC Silicon Scholarship

Awarded to students enrolled in the Industrial Electrical Technology, Maintenance Mechanical or Welding Technology programs.

Tech Prep Scholarship

For graduating high school seniors (2009) enrolled at a Tech Prep partner high school who has taken at least two full semesters or more of Tech Prep approved Career and Technical Education courses offered at the high school. Students need a “B” or better grade in high school Tech Prep courses.
